Five important concepts

- Find
- Contact
- Invite

FIND



those important associations you believe and have agreed upon which can help fulfill the aim of our project e.g.:

- Migrants' associations
- Cultural associations
- International friendship associations
- Other associations you consider being important for the project

CONTACT



- The associations you have found by calling a <u>person</u> or sending him/her a written letter in which you present yourself, your organisation AND the aim of the project
- Ask for a personal meeting, if required.

INVITE



- The person you have contacted to a meeting with other associations, if you have found any interested.
- Be sure to offer a time suitable for all invited.
- Tell how how long the meeting will take.
- Send a schedule of what will be discussed.

MEET



- All the organisations invited and present your organisation and the SAME-project
- Be sure a person in charge of your organisation is present
- Offer some refreshments



COMMUNICATE

- On a regular basis with the organisations invited after the meeting
- Send information about your plans for developing the educational organisation of yours
- If possible, start a project with one or more organisations to find methods how to make their members and your new students comfortable and make them feel safe in school
